

Medicaid Expansion Overview

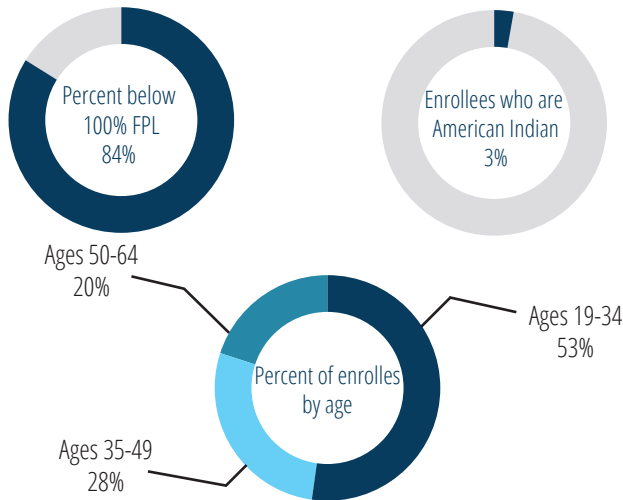

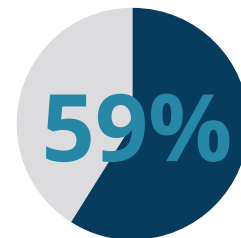
