

Medicaid Expansion Overview

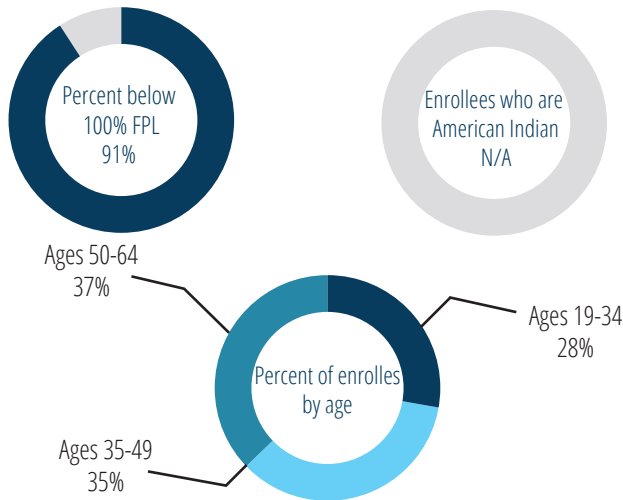
GRANITE COUNTY

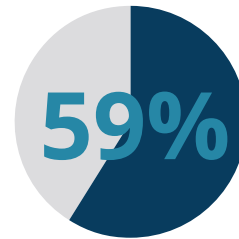
